Year 6 children will stay overnight on Tuesday 30 July.

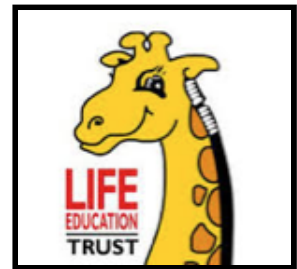
Year 5 children will stay overnight on Wednesday 31 July.
