2018 was successful for all of our teams, and our Central School values of personal excellence, respect, integrity, diversity, and equity (P.R.I.D.E) were evident in all of our sporting codes. Our school motto is to learn by doing, and taking up an extra-curricular sport will learn new skills and help your child to have new experiences, and socialise with students from other classrooms and levels. We aim to give children the opportunity to compete at their level.

This information sheet is to give you details about the sports we offer, and how you can get your child involved.

- Registration for sport is online through Kindo - see details below
- Please read your emails regularly. It is my preferred mode of communication. Once I have sorted teams out it is very difficult to accommodate late entries.
- Teams will only be entered in competitions if there is a coach and a manager and enough players.
- If you sign your child up to play a sport, it is important that they are committed and turn up to trainings and games. It is not fair on the other children in the team if they are the only players turning up each week and having to play full games because there are no subs. You will also need to take responsibility for your child at games as the coach and manager are there to oversee the team not to take responsibility for the behaviour of individual children.
- We will require a bond on issue of uniforms this year. Please return uniforms as soon as the sport season finishes. This will also be on Kindo next week.

### Sports offered at Central School:

#### Summer sports (run in term 1 and term 4)

- *Super Star Cricket*: Year 1 - 6 (Friday night 5:30pm), this is Kiwi and Incrediball. Uniform supplied.
- *The Super Smash (Primary)* - Year 4 - 6 (Saturday Morning 9am) Hardball. Uniform supplied.

- *Touch* - There is a competition at Bell Block run by SeaSide Touch in Term 1 (details yet to come). Usually played on a Monday night at Devon Intermediate in Term 4. Games generally run from 3.45pm and are finished by 6pm. Uniform supplied.
- *Inline hockey* - played on a Thursday evening at East End skate rink. Times vary but they generally run from 5.30pm to 8pm. Uniform to be confirmed.
- *Summer Football* - *this is a non-competitive competition that is designed to get children playing a sport.* played on a Tuesday evening at Merrilands Domain. Games start at 6pm. Each team has two games a night and each game runs for approximately 20 minutes with a 30 minute break between games. Uniforms will not be issued for Summer Football. Teams wear a yellow Central T-shirt (available for purchase from the office) and black shorts.
- *Year 1 & 2 netball* -RUN IN TERM FOUR.

### **Winter sport (run in term 2 and 3)**

- *Football and Rugby* - Families register with clubs.
- *Netball* - played on a Tuesday after school (year 5 & 6), and Thursday after school (year 3 & 4). Games are played at the Waiwhakaiho netball courts.
- *Hockey* - played on a Saturday morning at the Hobson Street turf.
- *Miniball/Basketball* - played at the TSB stadium. Miniball is for year 3 & 4 and Basketball is for year 5 & 6. The day is TBC.
